

# BOURGOGNE CUVÉE MARGOT 2011

## VINEYARD

We decided to blend vineyards from la Côte de Beaune, from Puligny-Montrachet to Pommard, la Côte de Nuits and old vineyards in les Hautes Côtes. About twenty different plots. Cuvee vinified from the purchase of grapes and from selected cuvees. Wine-Growing method : Sustainable Harvest: 80 % manual, 20% mechanical Soil : Stilty clay Production area : 1847,43 ha Altitude : 230-250 m Average age of vines : 25 years

## VINIFICATION

#### 100% Pinot Noir

At their arrival in our cellar, the grapes are carefully sorted in order to keep only the healthy grapes at an optimal ripeness 100 % destemed grappes Finning: yes 18 days of fermentation on the skins at cold temperature

15 months (whose 4 months in stainless steel tank) 70 % oak barrels (whose 20% of new oak)

12,5% vol.

# TASTING

### Tasting note

A flattering nose with aromas of small red berries (strawberry, raspberry). A fresh and elegant palate on crunchy fruits and fine tannins.

### Food pairings

Ideal with meat pies and spicy food.

Serving temperature : 16-18°C
