VINEYARD

The hillside vineyard, facing due east, divided into two parts of which the lower is clearly the better. There is plenty of clay in the soil but it's friable in nature, so easy to work.

Wine-Growing method : Sustainable

Harvest: 100 % manual

Soil : Calcareous Clay

Production area : 18,35 ha

Altitude : 250-300 m

Average age of vines : 35 years

VINIFICATION

100% Chardonnay

At their arrival in our cellar, the grapes are immediately and carefully pressed with a pneumatic press .

50 % crushed grappe, 50% whole berries

Fining: yes

11 months (whose 3 months in stainless steel tank) 100 % oak barrels (whose 25% of new oak)

13,5% vol.

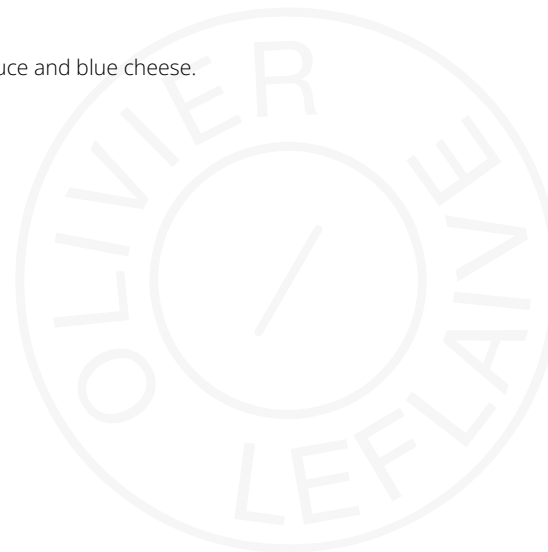
Tasting note

Ideal with poultry cooked in white sauce and blue cheese.

Serving temperature : 11-13°C
