VINEYARD

Located at the South border of la Côte de Beaune, the village of Santenay is very

Wine-Growing method : Sustainable

Harvest: 100 % manual

Soil : Calcareous clay Production area : 253 ha Altitude : 250-300 m

Average age of vines: 40 years

VINIFICATION

100% Pinot Noir

At their arrival in our cellar, the grapes are carefully sorted in order to keep only the healthy grapes at an optimal ripeness $\frac{1}{2}$

30% whole berries, 70 % destemed grappes

Finning: no

18 days of fermentation on the skins at cold temperature

15 months (whose 3 months in stainless steel tank) 100 % oak barrels (whose 25% of new oak)

TASTING

Tasting note

This wine shows an earthy but fresh nose which evolves into fruity glimpses on the palate. The flavors' weight, from light to medium, contribute to a beautiful balance and length, one of the best in its range.

Food pairings

Ideal with caramelized poultry or cheese such as Cîteaux and Bleu de Bresse.

Serving temperature: 17-19°C
